



A PASSION TO PROTECT THE PLANET

Lola Zhang's zeal for protecting the planet began when she was a high-school student in Yushu, China. Sandstorms would rip through the area, inspiring Zhang to do something.

She majored in environmental science and got her master's degree from Dalian University of Technology, where her favorite class was chemistry. After graduating, she began to work in China's automotive supplier industry, joining Magna in 2017.

"I know what kinds of chemicals pollute the environment," said Zhang, the health, safety and environment program manager based in Shanghai for Magna China Corporate. "I use my passion for the environment to help divisions reduce pollution during operations. I'm making a difference because I focus on the solutions, not the problems."

Her duties include plant inspections, where her keen eye can spot even seemingly minor concerns that can lead to best-practice recommendations.

Recently, Zhang toured a Magna division in China where she noticed some small stains on the floor near where electric forklifts were being recharged. She realized acid inside of the batteries was leaking due to overcharging. Her recommendation: install timers on the battery chargers to prevent the problem. Before leaving the factory, she took pictures of the floor and the forklifts with her iPhone, and later shared the information with her team and other divisions.

"Every time I confront a difficulty, the first thing that comes into my mind is how to fix it," she explained.

Protecting the health and safety of Magna employees is another key part of her job, one that has been focused on the COVID-19 pandemic in the past year.

"My reaction was to gather knowledge and guidance about COVID-19 and share it with the team," Zhang said. "I also called the divisions and asked, 'What do you need?' We gave them guidance on how to disinfect, wear masks, what to do with the plant canteens and more. The foundation of Magna's approach was prevention. And it worked. We have a stable situation in China today, but we still need to be cautious."

Her passion for the environment extends to her home life and vacation time. When she
